Overthrust Pipeline announces open season

SALT LAKE CITY -- Overthrust Pipeline Company (Overthrust), a wholly owned subsidiary of Questar Pipeline Company, is holding an open season to solicit binding support for an expansion of its system as well as non-binding support for an extension of its system to Wamsutter. Both “east flow” deliveries and “west flow” deliveries are being offered.

This expansion will create new delivery points with the ability to transport approximately 500,000 decatherms per day (Dth/d) of gas flowing west to Kern River Gas Transmission Company and Northwest Pipeline Corporation at Opal. In addition, Overthrust proposes to deliver additional volumes of between 500,000 Dth/d and 1.5 million Dth/d day flowing east from existing and proposed receipt points to downstream markets. Those markets include existing downstream pipelines such as Wyoming Interstate Pipeline Company, Colorado Interstate Gas Company, Northwest Pipeline Corporation and Questar Pipeline Company at Kanda, as well as the proposed large diameter long-haul pipelines destined to take gas supply to eastern markets. The proposed long-haul pipeline projects include those announced by El Paso, Kinder Morgan/Sempra and Northern Border.

Overthrust also is seeking non-binding expressions of interest to extend its system from Kanda to Wamsutter in this open season.

The proposed expansion is targeted to serve the transportation needs of the growing Rocky Mountain natural gas production areas in Overthrust's service area, including Opal, Wyo., and the Wamsutter, Green River, Piceance, Overthrust and Uintah basins.

Depending on customer response and the magnitude of the expansion, the anticipated in-service date could be as early as the first quarter of 2007.

The open season began at 8 a.m. MDT on Tuesday, Oct. 25, and will close at noon MST on Thursday, Nov. 17.
